Today, you can find Mike decorating donuts at the local and iconic, Dawn Donuts. "It's awesome. I really enjoy it," Mike shares.

But you can also find Mike developing his faith life. Since joining Carriage Town Ministries' program, he joined Flint Community Church and got baptized.

"You can get a lot of hope here," Mike says about Carriage Town Ministries. "It's a safe haven for anyone who is looking for assistance. They help you with everything."

Mike is currently looking for stable, long-term housing, but that's not going to keep him away from our doors. "I will volunteer here in the kitchen and help with the Blue Line Donuts program," Mike hopes.
